

*Call to Confession: Isaiah 25:4

Isaiah calls out, saying, "the earth lies polluted under its inhabitants; for they have transgressed laws, violated the statutes, broken the everlasting covenant." We live in a world of transgressions and broken covenants, and yet our God will not break his covenant with us. Because of God's faithfulness, we can join together and confess our own sins.

*Prayer of Confession:

Heavenly Father, we confess that we fear being tied down, trapped or constrained. Therefore, we are slow to make promises and quick to forget them. Whereas you freely commit yourself to us, we avoid commitment and the cost it might bring.

Forgive us for our carefree attitude toward things about which you care deeply. Forgive us for our careless behavior towards people to whom you are passionately committed. Grant us grace, through Jesus our Lord, so that we might joyfully live within the security of our covenant with you.
