#### Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Mark's account of Jesus' life closely parallels the Lord's Prayer. This section, Mark 1:1-3:6, connects powerfully to the line, "Thy kingdom come", as it details the inbreaking of the kingdom of God into a world already occupied by forces opposed to God. What does it mean for you to pray "Thy kingdom come"? What must happen to other kingdoms, if Christ's kingdom comes in its fullness?

Come, let us lift up our hearts to the Lord in our prayer of confession so we too may be restored.

Jesus, we come before you knowing that you grieve the hardness of our hearts. We are people who may follow rules to the letter, but don't always live up to our call as disciples of You. Please forgive our lack of compassion and help us to follow in your ways. Shape our hearts to look more like Yours.
