

*Call to Confession: Psalm 1:1

Despite the warning of the Psalmist, we are tempted by the advice of the wicked. The path that sinners tread has a broad gate and an easy path that looks attractive. The seat of scoffers seems comfortable. But these things take life, rather than giving life. So today we turn from those distractions back to our Savior, as together we pray.

*Prayer of Confession:

Like a river that brings living water to all who drink from it's banks, your word, O LORD, quenches our thirst and refreshes our hearts. But we make our homes far from you, traveling great distances to reach your life-sustaining power. We wander the desert regions, and return to the Scriptures only when other options leave us desperate.

Because we failed to plant ourselves next to your streams, your Word took on human form in Jesus Christ and came to us. In Christ, even our deserts can come to bloom. Through the Scriptures, draw us back to Jesus today, that we might always walk with him.
