Welcome & Explanation:

Tonight we invite you into a single day in the lives of six figures from the Gospel of Mark. Each will reflect on the central question of Mark – "Who was that Man?" – from their perspective on Holy Saturday, the day after Jesus' crucifixion and death. This day, the Sabbath of Holy Week, is the only day about which Scripture is silent. Please receive these stories, invented by us but influenced by Scripture, as an invitation for you to ask the same question about Jesus ... "Who was that Man?"

Call to Worship:

Behold the cross on which was hung the salvation of the whole world.

Come, let us worship.

Communal Prayer:

Lord Jesus, tonight we remember your sacrifice for us. On the cross, you, the Righteous One, became sin, so that in you we sinners might become the righteousness of God.

Tonight we confess that we, like the chief priests, the disciples, and the Roman guards, struggle to truly know you. We have imagined you in our own image, and discovered that you do not fit in our small imaginations.

But we want to know you. We want to know more of you. We want to know you, especially if it means being like you – in your suffering, in your death, and in your resurrection.

Holy Spirit, push aside our inadequate imaginary Jesuses, so that with your help, we can see the real Jesus tonight – who is truly God's Son.
