Paul's hope is that all believers "may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a cooked and perverse generation, in which you shine like stars in the world." We have not measured up to this ideal this week, and so we come together in our prayer of confession.

#### \*Prayer of Confession:

Father God, you invite us to live reflecting Christ, but we often fail to do so. Instead of asking what we can do for you, we imagine it is your job to fulfill our wishes. Instead of being blameless and innocent, we live comfortably with our sins because we take your forgiveness for granted.

Remind us again of the price paid for our redemption. Holy Spirit, give us the strength to partner with you in your work of salvation and kingdom-building, so that in you we can shine like stars in the world.

Over the centuries, many Christians have proposed a host of logical arguments for components of our faith - the existence of God, the reliability of Scripture, the reality of the resurrection, etc. Collectively, we call this work "Apologetics."
