Lighting of the Candles

Call to Worship: John 12:12-15

The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting,

Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord – the King of Israel!

Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it; as it is written:

Do not be afraid, daughter of Zion. Look, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!"

*Call to Confession: John 12:16

The crowds who enthusiastically greet Jesus today must also be confused at the sight of him riding on a donkey (for even "his disciples did not understand these things at first"). He is not the Messiah they imagined or expected. We too struggle when our imaginations of God contrast with the Image of God. Knowing this, we offer our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

LORD God, we have always been more ready to tell you who you should be than we are to listen about who you are. In the first covenant, we made a golden calf to make you familiar, instead of allowing you to be different and holy. Even now, we strive to constrain your Son into the image of a God we would imagine.

Jesus, we repent of our false assumptions about you. Father, we repent of believing that we can know you apart from your revelation and your Son. Spirit, we repent of ignoring the image of God in each of those around us. Move us today to know you – Father, Son and Spirit – and to join the voices shouting, "Hosanna!"

(We keep a moment of silence for reflection)
