

We see those who have indeed made poor choices, and we conveniently forget that we are guilty of similar or worse decisions. We accuse others of wasting their lives, but we do not seek out clarify from You, Holy Spirit, about is the right way to live our own. Lord God, forgive us for our sin. Forgive us for judgment, for hypocrisy, and for disinterest in your will. Inspire us today to find our role in your kingdom, and to value the roles of others.
