

*Call to Confession:

James 5:16

"Confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed." So says James, the brother of Jesus, and so we now together make our confession to God and one another. Please speak these words in your heart as I speak them aloud.

*Prayer of Confession:

Almighty God, we confess today that we struggle to worship only you. Like our ancestors, we have built golden calves, revealing with our calendars and our choices a set of priorities that has failed to place you first. You call us to worship in spirit and in truth, but our spirits are divided and your truth makes us uncomfortable. Worship in church sometimes feels old, stale or strained. And truthfully, we would often rather receive the praise of others than give our praise to you.

Lord Jesus, Son of God, have mercy on us. Overwhelm us with your worthiness today, and remind us again of your amazing grace, so that we might not only worship you well now but also offer our entire lives as living sacrifices for you. Then may we join with the joyous saints who daily cast their crowns before you, proclaiming that you are holy, gracious and good.
