Save us, O God, for the waters have come up to our neck. We sink in deep mire, where there is no foothold. The cords of sin have so easily entangled us; our selfishness has brought us shame.

Answer us, O LORD, for your steadfast love is good; according to your abundant mercy, turn to us. Draw near to us, redeem us, and set us free.
