You can read their stories in 1 Samuel 8 through 1 Kings 12. Why are these stories preserved by the Spirit in our Scriptures, and what can we learn about God and Christ through them?

\*Call to Confession: Psalm 51:6

David, after his great sin with Bathsheba and Uriah, writes Psalm 51, where he reminds us that God "desires truth in the inward being." Confession is the practice that brings truth in our inward being, as we become honest with God and ourselves and each other. Let us strive for that truth now, as together we pray using the words of Psalm 51.

### \*Prayer of Confession:

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned, and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are justified in your sentence and blameless when you pass judgement. Indeed, I was born guilty, a sinner when my mother conceived me.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, and do not take your holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and sustain in me a willing spirit.
