

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

This summer we "Return from Exile" with the people in the Book of Ezra. This is a long journey, not merely a single event. Have you had an experience of exile? How are you called to return to a spiritual life? Return to church? Return to God? What first steps can you take today on that long journey home to Christ?

Call to Worship: Ezra 5:1-2

Now the prophets, Haggai and Zechariah son of Iddo, prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them. Then Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel and Jeshua son of Jozadak set out to rebuild the house of God in Jerusalem; and with them were the prophets of God, helping them.

*Call to Confession:

Throughout history, God has raised up prophets to call us back to faithfulness. Yet we have often ignored, rejected or resisted their words. Today, we join with all God's people to make our prayer of confession. Please speak these words in your heart as I speak them aloud.

*Prayer of Confession:

O Word of God, even this week you have spoken to us. You speak through Scripture, but we have kept our Bibles closed. You speak through your prophets, but we prefer voices of comfort over words of challenge. You speak through your Spirit, but we convince ourselves that we cannot hear. We know that if we hear you, we must turn away from our old lives and reorder them according to your will; that is a price we are hesitant to pay.

But you, Lord Jesus, did not hesitate to pay the full price for us. You chose your Father's will before your own. And in your death and resurrection we are made new. Help us in becoming a people who long to hear your voice and do your will. Speak again to us today, Lord, and grant us the privilege to obey.

(We keep a moment of silence for reflection)

Paul encourages us, saying, "Who is to condemn? It is Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us." Believe the good news: because of Jesus Christ, we are forgiven! Thanks be to God! Amen.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

<u>TODAY'S COMMUNION</u>—Today we will celebrate the Sacrament of Communion. To participate at home, please have your juice and bread ready and available for today's live stream service. In-person worshippers will have prepackaged elements available to them.

WORSHIP RETURNING TO ONE SERVICE—Starting TODAY (Aug. 2), we are returning to our 10am worship hour for both online and in-person worship. This will be our format for at least August and September. For our in-person worshippers, we will maintain our current precautions (making reservations, social distancing in the Sanctuary, and refraining from congregational singing) with one change. Starting TODAY, we will ask that everyone who attends in person wear a mask. This is becoming more and more commonplace (even Wal-Mart requires masks!) and increasingly feels essential given our higher-risk population and hour-long service. If you would like to attend in person but have medical conditions that prevent you from mask wearing, please contact Jim Gates (jim@covenantcommunitypc.org). Children and Youth programming will remain online-only for August and September (except for outside youth programming, which may occur in-person provided social distancing is maintained). Beginning this month, adult programming (Bible Studies, Committees, etc) may opt to meet in person in the building provided that participants wear masks and social distance. Zoom options must be offered for all such programming for those who would prefer to remain at home. Each adult group may make their own decisions whether to offer online-only options, or a blended in-person and online option.

<u>IN-PERSON WORSHIP RESERVATIONS</u>—Reservations for next Sunday, August 9 will open *TOMORROW* (Monday) August 3 at 9am. Please go to *www.covenantcommunitypc.org/reservations* to secure your family's spot for the 10am service. You can also call the church office at 715-359-6467. We ask that you have your reservation completed by Thursday, July 30 at noon.

<u>SCRIP PROGRAM IN AUGUST</u>—Continuing in August, there will be a Scrip table set up for orders to be delivered on August 2nd. This will be a self-serve table that will include blank order forms, extra envelopes for those prepaying with check or cash, and a collection box for said forms and payments. Pens will be available with the understanding that you must keep the pen you use. Orders for the August 30th delivery must be submitted by Sunday, August 23rd.
