*Call to Confession:

O LORD, how many are our foes! Many are rising against us; not enemies of flesh and blood, but of temptation, of selfishness and of self-righteousness. This week, we have occasionally given in to those temptations and enemies. For this, we ask your forgiveness.

Rise up, O Lord! Deliver us, O Our God! You are our shield and glory in times of strength, and in our moments of brokenness, you, Lord Jesus, are the One who lifts up our heads again.
