

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

This summer we "Return from Exile" with the people in the Book of Ezra. This is a long journey, not merely a single event. Have you had an experience of exile? How are you called to return to a spiritual life? Return to church? Return to God? What first steps can you take today on that long journey home to Christ?

Welcome & Announcements

Call to Worship: Ezra 6:16, 22

The people of Israel, the priests and the Levites, and the rest of the returned exiles, celebrated the dedication of this house of God with joy. With joy they celebrated the festival of unleavened bread seven days: for the LORD had made them joyful. Let us also worship the LORD with gladness as we exalt his name together this morning.

*Hymn: "Shout to the Lord"

*Call to Confession: Hebrews 4:15-16

Here the word of the Lord: "We do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." Please speak these words in your heart as I read them aloud.

*Prayer of Confession: (from the Scotts Confession)

Holy Creator, we confess and acknowledge that you created us in your own image and likeness, so that in our whole nature no imperfection could be found. From this dignity and perfection man and woman have fallen, both conspiring against your sovereign majesty. We have shown ourselves hostile to you, and have made ourselves servants to sin. And thus everlasting death has power and dominion over us all, unless we are reborn from above.

By the power of the Holy Spirit, work this rebirth in us, creating in our hearts the confidence of chosen ones, with assured faith in your promise revealed to us in your Word; by this faith we grasp Christ Jesus with the graces and blessings promised in him.

(We keep a moment of silence for reflection)

*Assurance of Pardon:

Hebrews 2:14-15

We are God's children, and "since, therefore, the children share flesh and blood, he himself likewise shared the same things, so that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by the fear of death." Here is the gospel; in Jesus' incarnation, death and resurrection, we are set from from sin and death. Thanks be to God! Amen!

ANNOUNCEMENTS

PHONE/TEXT MESSAGES—You may have noticed that the church staff has begun utilizing text and phone messages over the past many months. This has become an invaluable way to communicate events, changes to programming, etc. We realize this takes some time to adjust and get used to. To that end, please note that if you receive a voice or text message from 715-200-5520, or 77411, this is not a scam or solicitation. We invite you to program these numbers in your phone as "CCPC" so that your caller ID identifies the messages as being from the church.

ADDRESS CHANGES—If you have recently moved, or plan to in the near future, please remember to let the church office know so that the information can be updated in the system. This is important for communications that are sent out, as well as contact information for other members.

WORSHIP RETURNING TO ONE SERVICE—Note that we have returned to our 10am worship hour for both online and in-person worship. This will be our format for at least August and September. For our in-person worshippers, we will maintain our current precautions (making reservations, social distancing in the Sanctuary, and refraining from congregational singing) with one change. We will ask that everyone who attends in person wear a mask. This is becoming more and more commonplace (even Wal-Mart requires masks!) and increasingly feels essential given our higher-risk population and hour-long service. If you would like to attend in person but have medical conditions that prevent you from mask wearing, please contact Jim Gates (iim@covenantcommunitypc.org). Children and Youth programming will remain online-only for August and September (except for outside youth programming, which may occur in-person provided social distancing is maintained). This month, adult programming (Bible Studies, Committees, etc) may opt to meet in person in the building provided that participants wear masks and social distance. Zoom options must be offered for all such programming for those who would prefer to remain at home. Each adult group may make their own decisions whether to offer online-only options, or a blended in-person and online option.
