But to all, Scripture calls for a single-minded evaluation of our lives. "Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ. More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord." Let us join in our prayer of confession together.

*Prayer of Confession:

Holy Father, you know that we have elevated other, lesser things above you in our lives this week. We have made conscious and unconscious choices to make you second, or third, or fourth in our decisions and choices. With extreme devotion we have pursued recognition, or entertainment, or romance, or family, or work.
