You can read their stories in 1 Samuel 8 through 1 Kings 12. Why are these stories preserved by the Spirit in our Scriptures, and what can we learn about God and Christ through them?

When Solomon's son reveals himself to be oppressive, the northern tribes of Israel rebel, saying, "What share do we have in David? We have no inheritance in the son of Jesse. To your tents, O Israel!" Their rebellion is not unlike our own; understandable, but regrettable. Let us therefore join in our prayer of confession.

## \*Prayer of Confession:

Today we will hear how Israel divided from the house of David, but the story is already familiar to us, O Lord. We see how Christians have divided into denominations, and how denominations divide still further. We see churches that split for a myriad of reasons. We see Christian families dividing, marriages ending in separation, friends parting ways due to irreconcilable differences. This division isn't just what other people do; we are quilty, Lord.

You tell us that the world will recognize us by our love for each other. We want this to be true. Today, Jesus, we come together to be one family, instead of many families. Today we come together despite differences and distance and denominations. Unite us in love for you and each other, that we may be the one witness of your kingdom on earth.
