September 12 - June 5 -Let's begin asking God, "WHAT'S NEXT?"



Without VISION, the people perish

Proverbs 29:18

The word translated "vision" here refers to prophecy. In other words, without hearing from God, the people perish. But we also need vision in the modern sense, as a picture of the future that guides our course like a rudder and a map guide a ship.

Life without vision — without a picture of a future hope given by God — leaves us rudderless. Without vision, we live our lives like pinballs, bouncing from one crisis to the next, always reacting and never acting.

Vision gives us direction, and courage to trust God's good plan even when it seems delayed or impossible.

God gave Abram and Sarai a vision of becoming a mighty nation — after they had passed childbearing age and centuries before that nation came into being under Moses. God gave visions and dreams to Joseph even as he was living as a slave and a prisoner in Egypt. The LORD sent Samuel to anoint David as king when David was just a teenager and another king was still on the throne — because God had a vision of what David might become. And for over a thousand years, God gave visions to the prophets of a coming Messiah.

Jesus, the master visionary, came to share his vision for the kingdom of heaven. Jesus' entire life, death, and resurrection was dedicated to this vision, and to shaping his disciples into the men and women he needed to advance that vision after his ascension.

What vision has God given us today – as a church, or as individuals? How do we discover God's vision for us, and how does it connect with God's great vision of the Kingdom of Heaven? What future hope do we share for our children and youth, our adults, our mission, our world?

In this season of our church, perhaps nothing is more critical than discerning the vision of Christ, and then following that vision courageously into the world. This year, let's begin by asking God, "What's next?"
