Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

We continue to use the Lord's Prayer to illuminate sections of the Gospel of Mark. In Mark 8:31-10:52, Jesus is teaching the disciples about the kind of Messiah he will be, and preparing the disciples for his suffering, death and resurrection. Throughout this section we see one temptation after another arise for Jesus and his students. Each time, Jesus will teach how to not be led away from him. What temptations do you face today? Have you asked Jesus to lead you away from them and towards himself?

This week, our belief and unbelief have been at odds. Sometimes our unbelief has won, leading us to live as though you are not present or not powerful. Forgive us, and help our unbelief, so that the faith and trust we experience on our mountain-tops can travel with us into our valleys.
