*Call to Confession:

In the Torah, we are reminded that touching anything unclean can make us unclean as well. This is true for dead bodies and diseased skin – our outer selves. But it's also true for our inner selves – our hearts and character. This week, in action and thought, we have touched the unclean. Let us acknowledge this together in our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

Lord God, you call us to be holy – separate, different, distinct from the world. But we are fascinated by the ordinary, the common, and the unclean. This week, in our haste to be ordinary, we fell into unclean behaviors and thoughts.

Wash us and make us pure. Give us a passion for purity and holiness, for goodness and grace. In Jesus' name we pray.
