As the kingdom expands, we get glimpses of what the world can be when people choose God's will to be done over their own. Each week we pray, "Thy Will Be Done." What does it mean to choose God's will over yours today?

#### \*Call to Confession:

When Jesus comes to visit his hometown of Nazareth, he is "amazed at their unbelief." This is a heartbreaking moment, but a familiar one. We know more about Jesus than even his neighbors and family, and yet we too sometimes strayed into unbelief this week. Let us therefore make our prayer of confession together.

#### \*Prayer of Confession:

Jesus, we know that you honor our doubts, but are grieved by our unbelief. We have been guilty of unbelief at times this week, when we have chosen to rely in other sources instead of trusting in you.

Today we reaffirm that you and you alone are supremely trustworthy. Today we chose to bring our doubts and questions to you, and entrust you with them, as we entrust you with all of our lives.
