### Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Mark's account of Jesus' life closely parallels the Lord's Prayer. This section, Mark 6:7-8:30, is bracketed with the feeding of the 5,000 Israelites and the feeding of the 4,000 Gentiles. As Jesus literally gives the nations their daily bread, his identity as the Messiah is finally revealed to his disciples. In this season of Advent, how are you also receiving your daily bread from Jesus? What does it mean for you to discover his identity as Messiah, and as King of Kings, through his provision for you?

His questions remain critical for us today. In a world filled with the majesty and miracles of God, how do we still fail to see, hear, understand and remember? Let us join together in prayer and confess these failures to God and one another.

# \*Prayer of Confession:

Father, we see "ordinary" miracles each day, and in this Advent season, we celebrate Christ's inbreaking into our world in the most extraordinary way. Yet we often complain that you are too hard to know, too distant and too demanding. Like the Pharisees, we observe one miracle and immediately ask for a sign of another. We struggle with spiritual satisfaction.

Forgive us for our hard-heartedness. Give us open eyes, satisfied hearts and understanding minds. You are more than enough for us. May our only insatiable desire be to see the nations come to know their one true King, so that your salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.
