Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Mark's account of Jesus' life closely parallels the Lord's Prayer. This section, Mark 6:7-8:30, is bracketed with the feeding of the 5,000 Israelites and the feeding of the 4,000 Gentiles. As Jesus literally gives the nations their daily bread, his identity as the Messiah is finally revealed to his disciples. In this season of Advent, how are you also receiving your daily bread from Jesus? What does it mean for you to discover his identity as Messiah, and as King of Kings, through his provision for you?

Lighting of the Candles

Lighting of the Advent Candles: Birchwood Highlands Group Isaiah 29:18-19 The second candle of Advent is the candle of peace. God's Shalom, or peace, is a tangible union between God and all creation.

Jesus embodies shalom, as in his incarnation he unites the Creator and the created. Jesus is fully God and yet fully human.

God's peace spreads from Jesus throughout the kingdom of God. Isaiah spoke of this, saying,

On that day the deaf shall hear the words of a scroll, and out of their gloom and darkness the eyes of the blind shall see.

The meek shall obtain fresh joy in the LORD,

And the neediest people shall exult in the Holy One of Israel.

*Call to Confession: Isaiah 29:13

Isaiah writes, "These people draw near with their mouths and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their worship of me is a human commandment learned by rote." Our words on Sundays do not always match our hearts on Mondays. Recognizing this in ourselves, we make our prayer of confession today in humility and remorse.

*Prayer of Confession:

Father God, we confess that we sometimes overstate our commitment to you with our words, and fall short in our actions. Even our worship is an unintentional act at times – a performance for others but not for you.

Today we want our offering to be more than songs and prayers; by your grace, help us to bring our entire selves as a living sacrifice to you. May our words and our hearts be united today, in Christ's name.
