Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Mark's account of Jesus' life closely parallels the Lord's Prayer. This section, Mark 1:1-3:6, connects powerfully to the line, "Thy kingdom come", as it details the inbreaking of the kingdom of God into a world already occupied by forces opposed to God. What does it mean for you to pray "Thy kingdom come"? What must happen to other kingdoms, if Christ's kingdom comes in its fullness?

Like those who John prepared for Jesus, we prepare our hearts by confessing and repenting of our sins. Let us pray.

*Prayer of Confession:

Father God, we confess that we have walked crooked paths this week, often more consumed with our desires than with your will. We have lived according to the values of the kingdoms of this earth, feeling like you and your kingdom were far away.

But as you sent John to make our paths straight, so you sent Jesus to bring your kingdom near. As a people baptized into your kingdom, O Lord, we pray that we can turn away from earthly attractions and towards Jesus, our one true king.

YOUTH, CHILDREN & FAMILY

YOUTH I.D. — All our youth I.D. classes run from 9am-9:50am every Sunday. Our Middle School I.D. class for 6th & 7th graders meets in the basement; our High School class for 9th-12th graders meets in the Bouldin Hall Loft.

At Wednesday night L.I.F.E., beginning *THIS* Wednesday, September 13 at 6pm, our first focus is a friendship with Jesus, and secondly, we encourage children to build relationships with other kids and adult leaders. This year we are excited to have an age specific rotation model so that we can connect with more kids doing the things they love to do.

BIBLE SUNDAY/COMMUNION CLASS — Sunday, September 24 will be a wonderful day of presenting Bibles to 3-year-olds, 3rd graders, and Confirmation students during worship! It is CCPC's tradition to share this gift with kids at important stages of growth and learning.
