Mark's account of Jesus' life closely parallels the Lord's Prayer. This section, Mark 1:1-3:6, connects powerfully to the line, "Thy kingdom come", as it details the inbreaking of the kingdom of God into a world already occupied by forces opposed to God. What does it mean for you to pray "Thy kingdom come"? What must happen to other kingdoms, if Christ's kingdom comes in its fullness?

Lighting of the Candles:

Call to Worship: Mark 1:16-18

As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea – for they were fishermen. And Jesus said to them,

"Follow me and I will make you fish for people." And immediately they left their nets and followed him.

*Call to Confession:

As Jesus begins his ministry, he calls people to follow him. This week, we have been tempted to be "believers" without being "followers." But mental acceptance of Jesus' identity does not make us disciples; even the demons believe that Jesus is the Holy One of God. Let us therefore confess our sins and choose today to follow him.

*Prayer of Confession:

Lord Jesus, we know that you have invited us to follow you, and so doing, to know you, the Spirit, and the Father. But we have attempted to make the call of discipleship easy and the cost minimal. We often prefer to cheer you on from the sidelines rather than get involved in the game.

Forgive us, Lord. Jesus, we are thankful that you chose to get involved in our lives and in our world. We are thankful that you paid the ultimate cost to bring us back to yourself. May we today leave everything behind that keeps us from following you.
