Treasurer's Report: Revenue and Expense Summary- September was a good month with total revenues of \$55,130. Year to date we are \$10,000 over budget for total revenues. Expenses in the month of September are slightly over budget due to timing of some bills. Overall, year to date expenses are under budget by \$11,000.

Endowment Summary –The end of September the balance was \$95,714. The additional funds that came in along with the matching gift should bring the Fund balance to around \$146,000 at the end of October.

Pastor's Report- Session Retreat dates November 3rd and 4th.
