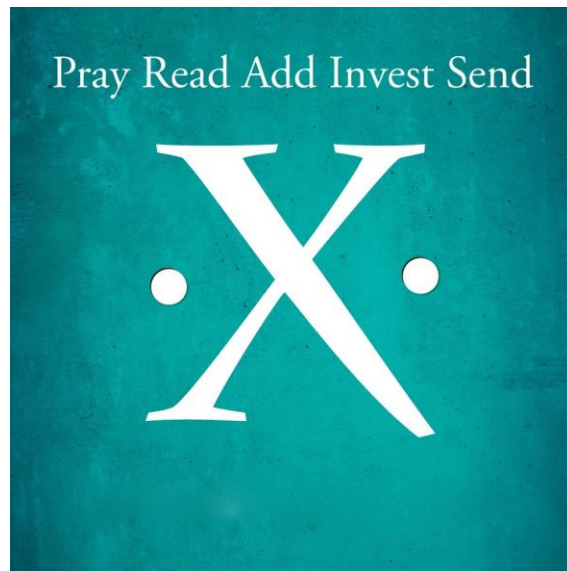

Pray for the Entire World in 35 Days

Why Pray for the Entire World?

Prayer is an amazingly powerful, and dangerous, gift. It is powerful because we are able to lay petitions at the throne of the Creator of the Universe. It is dangerous because those petitions reveal the deepest desires of our hearts, and too often, our prayers and desires are self-focused.

While prayer can and does change God's mind (Exodus 32:14), the primary purpose of prayer is to change our hearts and minds and to align with God's. Scripture is clear that our God has a heart for people throughout His entire world, not merely in the small space that we occupy. Thus we too must have a global vision – one that sees the unseen and loves those who are unknown to us but precious to our Father. Note that Christ does not present a false choice between the local and the global, the world and ourselves; He calls us to love and pray for all of the above.

We choose to adopt the spiritual practice of praying for the entire world so that the Holy Spirit might break our hearts for the things that break God's heart, and give us joy in the things that make God rejoice. As you work through the next 35 days of prayer, may you find your life changed, your priorities realigned, and your role in God's global Kingdom expanded and clarified. Join us in the ancient prayer – “May your Kingdom come, may your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”

How do I get started?

With this guide, you are well on your way! Be certain to take three simple steps:

How to Use this Book

Practical guidelines

- 1 This prayer booklet is intended to be prayed – not read.
 - a. Each section contains some prayer starters for you to expand upon. Our hope is that you will continue to pray for a minute or two more for each section.
- 2 The prayer guide is divided into four larger sections following the ACTS format for prayer (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication).
 - a. Each section gives you a few sentences to utter as you begin praying a specific topic. Use these sentences to begin your prayers or use your own words.
- 3 These guidelines are simply examples of how to spend meaningful time in prayer. You can replace any of the segments with another subject.

PRAYER TEMPLATE

1 ADORATION

- Love God and seek Him by calling on His name
- Focus on different attributes of God each day – every quality of God is worthy of praise.

2 CONFESSION

- Confessing our sins in prayer before God clears the way for a deeper relationship with Him.
- “If we confess our sins, He will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9.

3 THANKSGIVING

- Thank Him for what He has already done and will do. Thank God for people, things, events, and circumstances (both pleasant and unpleasant experiences should be acknowledged).

4 SUPPLICATION

- Ask the Lord to give you the desires of His heart.
 - (a) Pray for the world.
 - Pray specifically for your 200 million Christian brothers and sisters across the world who suffer for their faith.
 - Pray for the salvation of nonbelievers
 - (b) Pray for family, friends, your church, neighbors and coworkers (especially the unchurched).
 - (c) Pray for your personal needs.

DAY 1

1. ADORE GOD & SEEK HIS FACE BY CALLING ON HIS NAME

4. SUPPLICATION

(a) Pray for the world: North America: Canada; Greenland; St. Pierre and Miquelon

Today I lift up the Canadian people, so many of whom are Christian in name only and do not know the joy of having a personal and transformational relationship with Jesus Christ. Lord God, Canada needs you to breathe your Spirit of revival. I ask that you empower leaders who will speak out against the secularization and theological liberalization of your church. I pray that you would continue to bless the work of the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada, the National Evangelization and Catholic Christian Outreach teams who have led charismatic renewal. Please help these teams work together so that they can more effectively reach nonbelievers. Father, please give your believers an extra measure of humility, patience, wisdom and love so that they can overcome contemptuousness and suspicion from an unbelieving public and hostile media.

Lord, I also lift up the indigenous people of Canada. I ask that you raise up missionaries who will seek to evangelize and plant churches in the inhospitable northern parts of the country. There are still many native languages with no Scripture translation. Please bless the translators of the Canadian Bible Society who are working to translate the Bible. Lord I ask that you bless radio and TV programs aimed at the First Nations peoples.

Lord, I lift up Greenland which has been "Christianized", but not converted. Almost every community has a church building, but they lack real spiritual life. Please send your Spirit to indigenous

believers, missionaries and short-term workers as they seek to provide access to your presence through counseling, healing and deliverance. Also I lift up the islands of St. Pierre and Miquelon (South of Newfoundland) and pray that their people will find hope in a living relationship with Christ.

(a) Pray for the world: North America: Bermuda and the United States of America

Father, I lift up Bermuda and ask for revival for this country so that the lifestyles of the Christians are in line with Biblical truth. Please give Christian leaders unity as they seek to work together to bring revival to this small island nation.

Lord, I thank you for the many ways the Christian faith has helped shaped United States of America. I am thankful that many people are still allowing Christ to direct their faith and their call to social action and justice. I am grateful that our country has 17.6% of all Protestants in the world, 16.8% of all evangelicals in the world, and a significant proportion of all the world's foreign missionaries. Lord, I ask that you allow your Spirit to descend on our large population of Christ-followers so that they will be energized and mobilized to be used as beacons of light that guide all people to your truth.

I ask that you continue to raise up leaders who are obedient to the call of proclaiming your truth to our own nation and the nations of the world. Lord, please revitalize, revive and equip your Church to transmit the truth and power of the gospel to the entire nation. I pray that you will continue to embolden Christians to speak your truth in love and humility.

Lord, I pray for our youth and for the ministries that serve them. Lord, bless the ministries that serve our college campuses. Give them vision and leadership so that they can bring hope and purpose to our young men and women who are searching for meaning.

Lord, I pray that our nation's massive cultural and social influence be used as a force for good to bring hope and healing to the nations. Help us distinguish between what is scriptural and what is cultural. Please shape my life and the life of my nation to more closely reflect that of Jesus Christ.

(a) Pray for the world: Central America: Belize, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, México, Nicaragua and Panamá

Lord, I thank you for the mighty wave of evangelism that has spread through Belize, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama and Mexico. Yet, many of the new believers experience just shallow professions of faith and are never matured to become effective disciples. Please raise up leaders who are able to teach and disciple new believers so that they may live out your call of godly living, service and witness.

Father, I ask that you move the hearts of missionaries to respond to your call of equipping the saints. Please send people who are called to train and support local pastors. Most of these pastors work bivocationally and do not have the time or money for training to improve their biblical knowledge and learn models for ministry. Please help the pastors in these countries demonstrate Christ-like humility, graciousness, integrity and morality. Lord, guide these leaders as they seek to rise above petty divisions and pride. I pray that you will bless ministries like the Confraternidad Evangélica which works to cultivate fellowship and cooperation across denominations.

Defeat the powers of darkness driving drug cartels and violence. Because these countries have been plagued by civil war, natural disasters, drugs, and poverty, stable families are rare. Since young people have a natural need to belong to someone, they are joining and forming gangs that are becoming more violent and ruthless (Gangs have attracted up to 70% of the young men in El Salvador). Lord, they want to belong to someone; let them belong to you.

Lord, I pray, that you will continue to bless ministries that work to reach marginalized peoples such as the Amerindian (inc. Mayan), Garfuna (Black Carib), and Asian. Bless the Bible translation projects. Please help these ministries grow and raise up leadership that can persevere in the call of bringing the gospel to every tribe and every nation.

Lord, I lift up the persecuted church. Specifically I want to pray for Evangelical Christians in Mexico who live in the southern states of Chiapas and Oaxaca and have suffered lethal attacks and imprisonment from Catholics and the Caciques tribe who practice a religion that blends Catholicism with native religious beliefs. Please ease these tensions and protect the evangelical families who are suffering persecution at the hands of community leaders in Chiapas and Oaxaca. I ask that you give these an extra measure of faith so that they can be an example your love and grace to their tormentors.

4. SUPPLICATION

(a) Pray for the world: South America (Northern Coastal): Columbia; Ecuador, French Guiana, Guyana, Peru, Suriname and Venezuela

Lord, I pray for godly leadership of these countries. I especially pray the countries of Columbia, Ecuador, Peru, Suriname and Venezuela will find your peace amidst the violence. Let this violence awaken them to the fact that peace can only be found through a relationship with your Son, the Christ.

Father, I pray for your church in these countries. Fill them with evangelistic zeal so that they may overcome denominational lines and be effective witnesses of the gospel message. I pray especially for Venezuela, which bears the title of "the least church going nation in Latin America." Lord, raise up ministries that can help disciple your believers to be effective witnesses with both their words and their lifestyle. Meet physical needs in Venezuela as well, which is devastated by society-threatening food shortages.

Lord, I pray that your truth to be revealed to the indigenous tribes of these nations. I pray for missions to the animist tribes of French Guiana who are the least evangelized of all the tribes. I lift up the over Bible translation projects that are working to bring the Bible to over 70 language groups in these countries.

I ask that Christians hear your call to serve as missionaries to Suriname (23% Hindu, 14% Muslim) and Guyana (25% Hindu, 7% Muslim). Please raise up believers who can effectively evangelize to these groups.

Lord, today I lift up the persecuted church in Columbia. I ask that you soften the hearts of the Marxist guerrilla group Armed Revolutionary Forces of Colombia (FARC) whose violence has produced more than 7.7 million internally displaced persons. May the peace accord forged in 2016 become the foundation for a lasting openness to the gospel. Raise up Christian leaders, as many pastors have been assassinated or left the country. Missionaries are targets of kidnap, murder and extortion. Recent reports indicate that members of the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) have conducted internal searches to discover if there are Christians in their ranks. Sources say “many of their own” have been killed after they were discovered to profess faith in Jesus Christ. Father I ask for protection and an extra measure of courage and faithfulness for the new believers and lay leaders.

Lord, allow your spirit to descend upon these dark forces of the enemy “to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in [Christ].” Acts 26:18.

4. SUPPLICATION

(a) Pray for the world: South America (Middle and Southern Section): Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil; Chile, the Falkland Islands, Paraguay and Uruguay

Lord, I thank you for the recent evangelistic growth in Argentina, Brazil, Chile and Uruguay. I pray that the Spirit will continue to draw many to Christ and do a deep work in believers. Unfortunately, this increased hunger and spiritual openness has drawn people into spiritism and cults as well. I ask you to protect those who are seeking and surround them with believers who can guide them in your ways of truth.

Father, I ask that you continue raise up ministries that can help equip and teach the pastors and lay leaders of your churches in the countries of South America. There is a desperate need for more trained pastors, priests and lay leaders in these countries to disciple new Christians. In Brazil alone there is a need for 100,000 more priests to meet the needs of the people. Many of the new Christians live in extremely remote and isolated communities without links to the global church. Unfortunately, this leaves the door open to theological error and abuse. Help these leaders remain humble servants of your truth and remember that they are one body and are all united through Christ.

There is a great need for youth and children’s ministries in Bolivia as 67% of the population is under 35. Most of these children are raised in chronic poverty and this makes them susceptible to engage in and

become victims of crime. I ask that you raise up leaders who see it as their mission to evangelize, equip and train the young to be carriers of hope and healing to the nation.

Lord, I pray for renewal for the nominal Christians of South America. There are many immigrants who identify themselves as “Christian” but they are not following the way of Christ. Lord, help them to remember who they are and whose they are.

I ask that you remember Brazil, which is plagued by poverty. 10% of all homicides world-wide happen in Brazil; most are firearm deaths (40-60,000 last year). They are also the second highest consumer of illicit drugs. I pray that you will move people to minister to those who feel marginalized and hopeless. This includes the Amerindians of the Amazon basin, the large immigrant population (Brazil has over 1.5 million Japanese) and the millions who live in poverty. Brazil has the capacity to bring healing to itself through Christ. Thank you for the over 34,000 Brazilian missionaries sent out globally (Brazil ranks second world-wide for missionaries sent, behind only the US).

(a) Pray for the world: The Caribbean Islands: Aruba, the Bahamas, Barbados, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Cuba, Grenada, Jamacia, Saint Vincent & the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks & Caicos, US Virgin Islands

Lord I thank you for the work that you have done in Cuba. The opposition and hostility toward the church has refined your believing community and they have grown in numbers, confidence and spiritual maturity. I thank you for ingenuity of the Christian pastors who circumvented the strict zoning codes for churches by building churches without walls. Lord, I ask for your protection on pastors for they are frequently targeted by governmental threats, harassment, intimidation and arrest.

Lord, I pray for the millions of visitors to the Bahamas, Cayman Islands, Jamaica, and the British and US Virgin Islands each year. May they be confronted by the claims of Christ while in pursuit of pleasure. Please protect the local Christians from materialism and give them confidence to witness to tourists and immigrants.

The majority of the residents of these islands self-identify as Christian, but true disciples faithful to God's Word are not so common. Lord, I pray for your Spirit of renewal to descend upon these islands in the

midst of nominal faith, incorporation of the occult and other worldviews, and decreasing church attendance. Lord, please revive and restore biblically-based, Spirit-led Churches.

Lord, your Church is one of the only structures connected to every community, and therefore has enormous but unrealized potential to bridge the racial divide. I pray that churches of all these islands will be used as instruments of reconciliation and demonstrate that all are one in Christ.

Lord, I ask that you empower the churches of Jamaica to stand together with courage, moral integrity and determination to turn the country back to God. Jamaica has become a transshipment point for cocaine destined for the USA by powerful South American drug cartels. This fuels violence, reflected in a growing murder rate that affects all communities.

Lord, there is significant poverty in Jamaica, Turks and Caicos. Often the very poor have little exposure to your word except by radio. I pray for the whole gospel to touch the lives and communities of Jamaica, Turks and Caicos. Lord, move your churches to offer effective programs for children and youth, while demonstrating personal and positive holiness.

You are the Omniscient God....

Only You, O Lord possess perfect knowledge. You have no need to learn because you are all-knowing. You know everything, and your knowledge is infinite. I am unable to hide any thing or any thought from you. You are everywhere at once. "O LORD, You have searched me and known me. You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you understand my thought from afar. You scrutinize my path and my lying down, and are intimately acquainted with all my ways. Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O LORD, You know it all." (Psalm 139)

Like so many nations in Europe, these countries have seen a dramatic decline in the number of Christians in this generation. I ask you to bring revival to these materially prosperous, but spiritually poor lands. I also lift up the Muslim communities in these countries which are troubled, seeing a backlash from a suspicious majority and facing a violent faction within their midst. I thank you for the steady trickle of Muslims believing in Christ; I pray that the trickle becomes a stream and then a torrent.

Lord, I lift up nations like Luxembourg, Liechtenstein and Monaco, who, like so many nations in Europe, have a strong Christian heritage but a small percent of worshippers. Let them return to their first love.

Lord, I lift up Germany. Lord, this nation's spiritual health is failing, your Church is widely perceived as irrelevant and open hostility to anything Christian is increasing. In addition, thousands are formally disaffiliating in order to avoid the church tax of 8-9% of their income tax, and many churches are closing. Lord, Germany needs another reformation as deep and lasting as the one sparked by Luther nearly 500 years ago. I ask you to continue to bless the German evangelicals who have planted over 1,000 churches in the last 15 years. Lord, I especially pray for Eastern Germany which must overcome three generations of imposed atheism before the Church can flourish, and where about 80% are effectively unevangelized and 65% are either agnostic or atheist.

Lord, I ask you to lift the social and spiritual malaise of these nations caused by wealth and comfortable living. Lord, there is a serious need for more pastors, and I ask you to raise up godly clergy who will preach Biblical truths.

Thank you for what you are doing in Austria, where 84% of Austrians believe in God (high for Europe). I pray that these nominal Christians will be filled by the living presence of Christ. Despite this belief, Austrian churches have been in steady decline for decades. Please send in your spirit of renewal among your church where formalism and tradition have pushed away the younger generation. I pray that the people will turn away from popular New Age movements, Eastern religions, Jehovah's Witnesses (more numerous than evangelicals), Mormonism and the New Apostolic Church which have gained thousands of followers. Continue to bless the groups of evangelical pastors and lay leaders who seek to deepen spiritual life and combat theological liberalism within the Church. I pray that your Spirit will move in these churches and make them a force for the evangelization of the land.

Lord, I ask that you continue to bless the fast-growing minority churches of France, Spain, and Italy, especially Africans, Antilleans, Eastern Europeans, Latin Americans and Gypsies. Intercede and lift the restrictions that are often placed on non-Catholic groups so that they can operate legally with the necessary permits and licenses.

Lord, I lift up the nations of France, Spain, Italy and Andorra where occultism continues to be alarmingly widespread. There are more people earning a living in occult practices (soothsayers, prognosticators, healers, etc.) than pastors and missionaries in France. I pray that those who are seeking answers through occult practices will turn away from them and toward you.

Lord, I lift up the ongoing European theme of cultural secularism. Reveal yourself in France, where 40% of the French people reject a belief in any religion, less than 10% own a Bible and 80% have never even

touched a Bible. Reveal yourself in Portugal, where only 3% of people attend mass regularly. Please raise up Christians who are prepared to patiently and relationally share Jesus with those who seek.

Father, the end of Spain's dictatorship brought religious freedom and economic advancement, but it has also struck a crushing blow to traditional foundations of society and created a spiritual vacuum that is being filled with many dangerous elements. Around two million Spaniards (most of them young people) constitute the world's heaviest users of cocaine, heroin and marijuana. It is estimated that 15% of net household income is spent on gambling. Lord, I ask that you send renewal to Spain so that they will discover that a relationship with Jesus is the only path for healing and wholeness

Lord, I lift up the Italians, most of whom are culturally Catholic, but increasingly cynical about the Church. Less than 15% (but as low as 3%) of Italians faithfully practice Catholicism. Lord, I thank you for the work of the Catholic charismatic movement which has had some success sharing the gospel message. I pray that the millions of Italians, either locked in dead traditions or disillusioned by organized religion, will discover the living Christ.

Lord, I pray for renewal in the Orthodox Church in each of these nations, which is experiencing the familiar European disconnect between church membership and church attendance. Thank you for the small signs of hope, and reignite those believers as fully committed disciples.

Lord, I grieve the role of Serbian Christians in the ethno religious hatred, ethnic cleansing and war atrocities of the 1990s that continue to shape the region. I beseech you to do a mighty work that will bring healing and true reconciliation to the region, maintaining the fragile peace. Please bring new life within the Orthodox Church so that it will support true religious freedom. I pray that the tiny evangelical community – the only body that has retained multi-cultural fellowships – might prove a catalyst for good. I lift up the organized crime and poverty rampant in these post-Yugoslav nations and the instability of governments like that of Bosnia.

I ask that awaken people to your call to bring the love of Christ to Bosniak Muslims who are possibly the least evangelized people in Europe.

Reverse the trends of unbelief in nations like the Czech Republic, where 40% of people named themselves atheists in 1991: 60% in 2001; and 71% in 2010. Lord, I grieve for the fact that there are more abortions than live births in the nation of Romania. Lord, send renewal. Thank you for the progress and decline of abortion in Hungary; please continue this movement. For those oppressed by ongoing substance abuse, prostitution, and human trafficking, particularly in Moldova, the source for the greatest number of young women in human trafficking rings, bring transformation, hope and freedom.

Jesus, grant boldness and courage to believers in Hungary where restrictions forbid teachers, doctors and such from sharing their faith in the workplace. In several of these nations, Muslim missionaries outnumber Christian missionaries; raise up leaders for your church, and ambassadors to the growing Muslim communities.

Thank you for the good news of growth in Romania, which is predominantly Orthodox, but has Europe's fourth largest evangelical population and this despite an overall decline in population. I praise you for the 6,000 congregations planted since the fall of communism and the vision for continued growth. Lord, continue to bless the Lord's Army renewal movement within the Orthodox Church of Romania and I pray that this movement will inspire similar movements in other nations. Similar movements, like the Family Fellowships focus in the Lutheran church of Slovakia, could become great tools for your kingdom's growth. Please continue to send renewal to your people and awaken those whose faith lies dead or dormant. Open the eyes of believers to the suffering around them and provoke them to minister to their broken communities.

Lord, I thank you for the fall of the Iron Curtain, which opened these countries to unprecedented access to the good news. Yet, the affects from an oppressive regime are still being deeply felt and there is still widespread government corruption causing poverty, unemployment and economic struggles for pensioners, teachers, doctors and other state employees. Lord, I pray that you will use these struggles to draw people to you as they realize that you are the only source of security and peace. Please raise up compassionate, righteous and just leaders who are bold in their faith.

There is so much to be grateful for! Lord, I am thankful that Poland is one of the most religious states in Europe and that the vast majority of Poles consider themselves Catholic - most still committed to their faith, but only a third attend mass regularly. Lord, I ask you to send renewal to the Catholic Church. Lord, I thank you for rich Christian heritage of Ukraine which was once considered the Soviet “Bible Belt”. I thank you for the recent successful house church movement which has seen great growth both in Ukraine and neighboring countries by focusing on relational outreach, lay leadership and reproducing churches. Please continue to bless ministries that serve hundreds of thousands of students, millions of homeless youth, and over 650,000 orphans. I lift up the significant numbers of Christians who are specifically reaching out to Crimean Tatars (predominantly Muslim – although often nominally) and Ukrainian Jews who are responsive to the gospel. The increasing numbers of Tatar believers are noted for their fiery faith. Finally, I give thanks that your

church in Russia has more than doubled and those identifying themselves as non-religious has dropped by more than half since the fall of communism.

Yet there is such a great need in these nations. There are increasing signs that the Russian people are feeling hopeless: among the lowest birthrates in the world even though the government is offering generous incentives to reproduce; one of the world's highest abortion rates (like Romania, the abortions exceed live births); one of the world's highest alcoholism rate; and over 2.5 million people are drug addicts (8% of teens used drugs daily). Lord, I ask you to send renewal and hope to the people of Russia. Father, I especially pray for Chechnya where the Christian presence has already been eliminated, and I entreat you to place a hedge of protection around the few remaining Christians of the Caucasus region.

In the other nations in this region, there are similar signs of social dysfunction, immorality and brokenness. May your church shine as a light and direct people to the life offered by Jesus Christ.

Lord, I thank you that the Kazakh Church has grown in the past two decades – from almost none to about 15,000 who meet in over 100 Kazakh-speaking congregations. Yet, persecution is increasing and only traditionally recognized groups can operate freely. Lord please strengthen and protect new converts from Islam for they face harassment from family members, authorities and strident Muslims. Lord, I ask that you renew and strengthen the faith of the large numbers of Russians and Ukrainians who have immigrated back to their ancestral homeland of Kazakhstan and bless the ministries that have just recently completed translating the Bible into Kazakh. Father, I ask that you open the ears of believers (indigenous and foreign) to hear your call to full time mission work in Kazakhstan as there are many needs including: reaching the unreached; training; discipling; and work focused on material needs.

Lord, please protect the Christians in southeast Uzbekistan where police have campaigned to prevent children from attending worship services. I am thankful that in the past two decades, 25,000 ethnic Uzbeks have turned to Christ. Please shield the approximately 65 unregistered Christian fellowships from surveillance. Lord, I ask that you give courage to Christian pastors and leaders who are serving as your witnesses in prison because religious activity. Please fortify them and let them feel your presence in this difficult time and place. Please intercede so that they will be set free.

Jesus, be with your nation of Kyrgyzstan. Move the governmental leaders to relax the rules regulating the establishment of new churches. Lord, please protect the new believers who convert from the

Muslim faith as they are viewed as traitors to the Kyrgyz traditions. Help these new Christians to walk without fear and have peace. Protect the Christian converts in rural areas from the strong pressures from families and the authorities to renounce their faith. Lord, bless the small Bible schools and training programs that have been started to prepare the Christians for ministry. Thank you for the workers who recently completed a new translation of the Bible into the Kyrgyz language.

Lord, I pray for the government and president of Tajikistan. Father, encourage the Tajik authorities to continue their policy of non-extremism in the face of those who would see escalating Islamic fundamentalism. Lord, I thank you that the birth of the Tajik Church, although a slow and painstaking process, is now reality. Please nourish these communities of faith (only a thousand people, but growing) so that they can develop their own style of worship in their own language. Father, please shield and strengthen my brothers and sisters in Tajikistan who face religious persecution. Lord, there are many remote villages that have not heard the Gospel. Please open doors so that Christians may have opportunities to minister to the Tajik people.

Lord, I pray that Armenian Christians will realize the blessing of their long Christian heritage and become sources of light and blessing to the surrounding region, and I pray for unity and cooperation within the Eastern and Western Church (they use different dialects) so that they will work together for the glory of

the kingdom. Lord, continue to bless the Armenian Church-Loving Brotherhood which emphasizes Bible study groups, personal witness, publishing and distribution of evangelical literature and Bibles, and work among the poor and needy, especially orphans.

Lord, the help move the nation of Turkey toward true religious freedom. Please be with Christian converts from Islam for they face social harassment and violence from relatives and neighbors. Lord, help these new believers who are facing intimidation and threats to stand firm in their faith.

Father, I praise you for your mighty work that has grown the number of Azeri believers from a mere 40 to over 3000 (some estimates are 6000) in two decades. I am thankful for Azerbaijan's constitution, which guarantees freedom of religion. I pray today for the Christian communities who are monitored by the secret police and local authorities. Please protect the more than 400 unregistered evangelical churches, which are often raided. Please strengthen and shield the pastors who come under great pressure from the authorities and protect their ministries. Father, I pray that your Church can be a beacon of hope to the majority of the population who live in poverty.

Father, I lift up the new believers from Muslim backgrounds who often face rejection by family, friends, and even Christian churches. Lord, give churches the courage to face their fears about Muslim-background believers.

Father, in the midst of the ongoing civil war, bring peace, democracy and religious freedoms to Syria. Please bless the 5 million of refugees and 6 million internally displaced persons; we remember that you, Lord Jesus, were a refugee. Call upon Christians world-wide to welcome them as you were once welcomed into Egypt. Lord, let the church that remains in Syria be strengthened to become a beacon of light and hope on every side of the conflict. Please give believers from Christian and Muslim backgrounds courage and wisdom as they evangelize.

Do not let your church be forced from the lands of our spiritual ancestors, of Abraham, Joshua and David.

Bring about a lasting peace between the nation of Israel and the people of Gaza and the West Bank that ensures the safety of all parties; let Jews and Muslims live without fear of one another. Only you can do this. Lord, I thank you for the increasing interest in the gospel and the rapidly rising numbers of Messianic Jews (now up to 20,000). Messianic Jews (Jews who accept Jesus as Lord and Savior) are becoming a recognized part of Israeli society, but greater growth has intensified persecution. Even globally, there is a significant response to the gospel among the 14.5 million Jews. Lord, help the Israeli Jews see Christianity as fulfillment of their Jewish heritage and not a destroyer of the Jewish nation.

Lord, I thank you for your provision in Jordan's constitution allowing for freedom of religion, yet leaving the Islam faith is still prohibited so I ask that you continue to soften the hearts of Jordan's leaders. Lord, there have been instances of pastors and Christians being deported for their evangelism efforts; raise up two witnesses every time a foreign Christian is deported for 'illegal' missionary activities. Lord, I also lift up the nearly millions of Syria, Palestinian and Iraqi refugees and ask that you give your people the heart to incarnate your compassion in such a way that these refugees will want to know you. I pray that the Jordanian churches will burn with their love for you and will catch a vision of reaching the surrounding nations.

Please protect the new converts from Islam who often face the death penalty under Islamic Law if their new faith is discovered. Please provide the secret believers, who are often isolated and lack teaching, the resources to help them grow in their faith.

Jesus, intervene in Yemen, where the civil war continues and as many as 13 million people face starvation because of the violence. Lord, pour out an extra measure of blessing for my brothers and sisters in Yemen who are suffering for your name. Kidnappings and martyrdoms are not uncommon for Christian aid workers. Move in the hearts of the authorities to prevent these abuses, and shield the approximately 100 Yemenis who trust you in Christ as their Savior.

Softens the hearts of Oman’s sultan and his appointed cabinet so that they will allow freedom of religion. Strengthen the very small number of active churches (made up largely of foreign workers) and bless them as they seek to share the Gospel with the people of Oman. Lord, I thank you for the steady stream of conversions among Asians working in Oman. Encourage, and protect the Omani Arab Christians.

Lord, I thank you that the constitution of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) provides for freedom of religion, although only foreign Christians may worship Christ and witness freely to the indigenous UAE citizens. Give Christians wisdom as they seek ways to share the Gospel with Muslim believers (evangelizing Muslims is strictly forbidden). Lord, I pray that expatriate churches will awaken to see the plentiful harvest that you have set before them (80% of the population are foreign workers). Unsettle the hearts of the citizens who are rich in material wealth, so that they will not be satisfied with earthly riches, but instead seek heavenly riches through Jesus, the greatest treasure to be found.

Holy Spirit, thank you for softening the hearts of those in the Qatar government who signed a fifty-year lease with representatives of Christian churches for a large piece of property in the capital Doha for the purpose of erecting six churches at the churches' expense. Please allow this area to be a beacon of light to the nation. I ask that you provide avenues of Christian growth for the women of Qatar who live under very harsh rules. Please protect the believers who talk about their faith and give them wisdom as they talk to Muslims as proselytism of Muslims is forbidden.

Lord, I thank you for Bahrain's huge expatriate work force (50% of labor force) which has helped this government be more tolerant towards foreign workers worshipping and practicing their faith. Please soften the hearts the king and the leaders of this country to allow true freedom of religion. Open up the hearts of the Bahraini people to hear your message of the Gospel.

Father, I thank you for the Kuwait constitution that provides for freedom of religion even though there are some limits on religious practice. Lord, help the Kuwaiti people see the emptiness of riches and the true wealth of the Gospel. Lord, I ask that you reveal yourself to key leaders so that avenues of evangelism can be formed.

Father God, I ask that you move the hearts of the government leaders of Iran so that mission organizations will be allowed to enter and be your hands to the Iranian people. Lord, I thank you that Nepal, which was once the world's only Hindu Kingdom, has enacted a law that allows freedom of religion, if only in limited measure. Lord, give Nepal's leaders wisdom, courage and grace so that they might put personal or party differences aside and work together to fight the immense economic problems still gripping the country. Thank you for the 2017 Labor Law designed to reduce the epidemic of child labor and child slave labor. Lord, I praise you for the recent growth of the Church in Nepal largely because of courageous evangelism. Please raise up Christian ministries who: provide education programs to children to get them out of the workplace (2.6 million children work as child laborers; 70% of them are forced to work 10-hour days or longer); reach and rescue the hundreds of thousands of Nepali and in Mumbai girls who are exploited for the Middle Eastern and domestic sex trade; work with lepers. Please protect and strengthen Christian converts from Hinduism because they usually become outcasts – as lowly as the Dalits who are very much oppressed. I pray that you will provide them with new family and social supports for they are usually shunned by their families and communities.

Father, I ask that you soften the heart of the Bhutanese King so that he will recognize the injustice of criminalizing public worship and evangelism by non-Buddhists. I ask you to protect believers who meet in secret and face discrimination in education and employment. Please bless the Christian children so that they can grow in their faith even though they face discrimination and the constant pressure to attend Buddhist religious festivals. Please raise up leaders who can train and teach the small community of Bhutanese Christians.

I also ask for protection for believers on the island of Sri Lanka. These Christians have experienced increased violent persecution as well as discrimination in employment and education. Please protect your believers in this country and give them courage to claim you as their Lord and Savior.

Father, I sorrow with you that Maldivians are required to convert to Muslim or lose their citizenship. I ask you to protect the very few Maldivian believers who are constantly under surveillance. Give them strength and perseverance as they suffer ostracism.

Lord, I thank you for all the recent work done by Nongovernmental Organizations (NGO's) in the fight against poverty in Bangladesh which is among the world's poorest nations (gross over-population and periodic devastating floods and cyclones). Lord, I lift up the ethnic Burmese Christians who are singled out for repression because of the government's goal to create a uniform society of one language, one ethnicity and one religion. Awaken the world to the genocide that is happening today in Burma. Lord, I lift up the families and friends of the half million victims of the Burmese army's massive killing campaign against its people over the past few decades. Lord, please give protection to the heavily targeted Rohingyas, a Muslim ethnic-minority group, and also to the Christian Karen people. Be Father to the thousands of children who have lost parents from these brutal attacks. I also pray for the one million Burmese refugees who have fled across the border to Thailand who at any moment might be sent back to Burma to face certain death.

Father, please help my brothers and sisters in Laos who face severe persecution. Their situation is very volatile. Many of our fellow believers have been imprisoned for worshipping openly; others are forced to leave their villages with only the clothes on their back. I ask that the officials would become convicted of their injustice and allow these believers to return to their homes. Be with these church leaders and give them your strength to persevere in the midst of these trials.

Lord, I thank you that freedom of religion is guaranteed in the constitution of Thailand, even though the nation is less than 1.5% Christian. Lord, bless the Thailand Evangelism and Church Growth Committee which has bold plans to reach every one of Thailand's 80,000 villages and neighborhoods with the gospel through intercession and outreach.

Please raise up ministries in Cambodia and Thailand that work to deliver the youth from child labor, homelessness and sex trafficking. It is estimated that over three million engage in sex work and some claim 10-20% of all tourist to these countries make use of the sex trade, often with the young or underage. Lord, please help workers find ways to rescue the large number of girls involved (and the much smaller numbers of men) and bring your judgment on those who abuse your beautiful innocent children for their own pleasure and profit.

Lord, I thank you that Cambodian Christians have been allowed to worship openly, and for the unprecedented and unexpected church growth over the last two decades that has resulted in the Christian population doubling to 3.5% of the population. Bless ministries that reach out to young adults in relevant and meaningful ways (many were orphaned during the genocides of the 70's and 80's).

Father, please continue encouraging the Vietnamese churches in the face of the unreasonable restrictions that the government has imposed on registered churches and believers (arbitrary arrests, harassment and fines are common). I thank you that the government's efforts to intimidate the churches have resulted in increased church growth and outreach.

Please shield and support the indigenous secret believers and let them live in such a way that they will be a light to their neighbors and community.

Father, I pray for the light of your truth to shine in China. I ask for your mercy upon the Chinese people who live in a country with one of the worst human rights records in the world. Please pour out your love upon the hundreds of thousands of people each year who are forced to go through a system of “re-education through labor” in work camps without a court hearing. Lord, please convict the Chinese government of their lack of compassion towards the Christians who are forcibly repatriated to North Korea where they face imprisonment, torture and even execution. I pray for my Christian brothers and sisters in Tibet who are trapped between the oppression of Buddhism and the oppression of communism. Please shield and strengthen the many Christians who are in prison or under detention in China (more than in any other country). Encourage the worshippers in house churches (unregistered churches), which make up approximately ninety percent of China's Christians, as they endure constant persecution. Despite this persecution, your church in China continues to grow at an incredible rate!

Please continue to strengthen and give hope to the one in four North Korean Christian worshippers who live in prison camps (about 40,000); most of them will never leave their imprisonment on earth. May these Christians display the refreshing righteousness of Christ in the midst of a nation struggling with corruption, dictatorship and injustice.

Lord, I praise you that South Korea has become a bastion of Christianity in so many ways. Father, thank you for blessing this nation with six of the ten largest churches in the world, for making them one of the largest foreign-mission-sending nations with over 20,000 missionaries sent, and for their remarkable commitment to prayer: early morning and evening prayer meetings every day and all night; prayer concerts on weekends and prayer mountains (retreat centers). Guard Christians from the materialism which is increasing in this society.

Jesus, I thank you for the growth of the Mongolian church from just four Christians to 40,000 Christians in the past two decades. Lord, I praise you for religious freedom in Mongolia although there are some restrictions on foreign religious Workers.

Lord, I grieve over the lack of faith in Japan, one of the least Christianized nations in the world. I pray for the many young people who struggle with self-worth, resulted in a suicide epidemic (dipping below 30,000/year but still terribly high). Please bless the Japanese Church so that they can be a beacon of light to the nation. Jesus, protect the people from the great numbers of Mormon missionaries and the steadily expanding growth of the Mormon faith in places like Samoa and Tonga. Bring political stability to Fiji and a spirit of grace and repentance amongst the Christians there for their treatment of the Hindu Indians. Place a special protection around the people of Kiribati, as their entire nation faces eradication if the sea levels rise.

Thank you for the amazing willingness of Christians in New Zealand to be sent into the mission field, and the collective goal of many churches in that nation to send 1 missionary per 1,000 believers, amounting to 3,000 missionaries (twice as many as the current number). Grant them success in this endeavor!

Strengthen the church at home in New Zealand as well, where Christians are declining in number (59% of the population in 2001 to 49% in 2013). Lord, use those sent to witness to an increasingly secular population in New Zealand (41% of the population today defines themselves as “non-religious”). Especially

expand the church's mission to young people who are impacted significantly by the state's secular education system. Let your light shine in the darkness!

Lord, please raise up righteous leaders in Tunisia who will continue to uphold freedom of religion including allowing Muslims to convert to Christianity and extending visas to missionaries and mission workers. Thank you for the faithful believers in the city of Kairouan, which is considered to be the fourth holiest city of Islam and is the site of The Grand Mosque, and throughout the nation.

Father, please strengthen the few existing Libyan believers so they can grow strong in their faith and have opportunities to be discipled. Libya is ripe and needs more workers who can clearly present the Gospel. Place a call on believers in our country, and others, to carry your gospel to Libya.

Lord, I pray that you will place a hedge of protection around the Egyptian Christian communities as they seek to support and encourage those becoming Christians from a Muslim background. I pray that you will come along side the Egyptian Christians and provide them avenues of encouragement as they are not only treated like second-class citizens (politically, legally and in employment), but often suffer harassment, torture and ill treatment. In the name of the ‘Prince of Peace’, let your peace reign in Egypt.

Bring an end of civil war and a lasting peace to South Sudan. I praise you that in the midst of this suffering, the Christian population has increased tenfold and now numbers eleven million. Lord I pray that the Church might

play a central and redemptive role in shaping the future of the south. Lord, I pray that world will rise up and insist that the Northern Sudanese release all those they still hold in slavery.

Father, I know that you have a plan for Eritrea even through their devastation by war and drought. Lord Jesus, I ask forgiveness on the failure of the church to and in central Africa to teach a gospel that results in transformed lives. The conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding nations, ostensibly concluded in 2003, has caused more deaths than any since World War II. In 1994 in neighboring Rwanda, 1 million people were murdered by 2-3 million of their neighbors in a massive genocide. Angola's 40 years of war (1962-2002) produced massive casualties, 90% of whom were civilians, and resulting in a country where 1 in 350 Angolans is a victim of landmines and 70-90% of the population lives in poverty. Forgive us, and them, for allowing such violence and terror and suffering to be inflicted by people identified as Christians (in most of these nations, 80-90% of the population).

Father, only you can bring healing, reconciliation and peace to these nations and these people who have suffered so much. Bring protection to the poor, the weak, the orphaned and disabled, and let your church work for a level of sanctification in the lives of her members so that they might usher in a future completely divergent from the past. Let forgiveness of Christ reign in the hearts of your people and thereby conquer the cycles of violence and reprisals.

Thank you for the signs of hope – for the many faithful martyrs and stalwart believers in the midst of the many conflicts, for the increased stability in nations like Rwanda and Burundi and for the peace between Hutu and Tutsi. Thank you for Malawi, a bastion of political stability and peace (though terribly effected by HIV/AIDS).

Lord, bring the millions of displaced persons home (over 1.7 million in the DRC alone); the ongoing military conflicts with rebels concluded, and the failed governments of nations like the DRC rebuilt or replaced with effective leadership. Protect the people from spiritual evil that manifests in horrific practices of rape, witchcraft and mutilation. Make this truly a transitional generation for whom being a follower of Jesus shapes both individual lifestyle and community. Let your prayer be a reality in their lives; “forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”

Infection rates of 23-25% are common in most of these nations. Thank you for the progress in these nations in the last

two decades; continue to bring healing and hope those infected and affected, and especially to the children left behind. Grant that the church will offer compassion and support to all those suffering from this disease, while also lovingly teaching Biblical sexual standards.

Spirit, please also provide transformation in the lives of those caught in crushing poverty: in nations like Zambia, where more than half the population is under 18, and where 60% of children live in serious or extreme poverty. May your church become a vessel of hope and promise in the midst of what must seem like crushing despair.

May your Kingdom come, on earth as it is in heaven.

4. SUPPLICATION

(a) Pray for the world: Southeast Africa: Comoros, Madagascar, Mauritius, Mayotte, Mozambique, Réunion and the Seychelles

Father, alleviate the crushing poverty that grips so many of these nations, and bring a respite from the seemingly continual natural disasters (cyclones, floods and earthquakes) that have plagued Mozambique, Madagascar and other nations. Thank you for the peace and religious freedom enjoyed in Mozambique today after 30 years of war. Bring similar freedoms to Comoros and stability to Madagascar.

In the Muslim-majority nations such as Comoros and Mayotte, give the believers a boldness to share their faith without fear. In Comoros, I ask for protection for the very small underground Church movement with Bible study groups that meet regularly in homes. Lord, please bless the less than 200 Christian nationals there. The name Mayotte means “place of death” and I pray that this island will instead become a place of spiritual life in Christ.

Reach the unreached through your church. Mozambique has more unreached peoples than anywhere else in southern Africa, so I ask you to stir believers to reach out to the Makhuwa peoples (mostly Catholic-animistic or Muslim), The Yao (Muslim), and other northern/coastal Muslim peoples. Energize the nominal Christians who dominate the Seychelles, which are overwhelming Christian but who demonstrate little distinguishing features from nonbelievers.

Father, thank you for the continued growth of your church in nations like Madagascar and Reunion. In Reunion, I also ask for continued healing to a nation composed mostly of descendants of slaves, and which wrestles with huge challenges of poverty.

Lord, I lift up Mauritius where a complex multi-ethnic and multi-religious society makes evangelism a challenge. Lord, give believers wisdom and discernment as they seek to evangelize this predominantly Hindu nation. Please protect the evangelical and independent house groups who are often targets of opposition such as subtle discrimination when applying for official permits and more open hostility when sharing the gospel. I pray for unity among Christians to deepen, to inform ministry and strategy, and to shape a positive testimony to non-believers.
